Dear Parent/Guardian,

I have planned a school trip to watch 'Blood Brothers' at the Ambassadors Theatre, Woking on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> of April 2020.

The trip is aimed at those drama students who are interested in taking drama for GCSE, as part of the course would be to analyse live theatre, so those students will have priority. It is, however, open to all students from all year groups.

The show starts at 7.30PM and will finish at 10.25PM. Students will be expected to make their own way to the theatre and meet at the Box office at between 7 and 7.10PM and be picked up by their parent/carer from the Box Office.

The cost of the trip will be £22 and there are only 18 places available; it is first come, first served. All transactions will be done through Parent Pay.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your son/daughter to not only watch live theatre but to show their love and interest in drama.

If you successfully pay for this on Parent Pay, then please complete the slip at the bottom - and students are expected to hand these directly to me by Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> of December. Both the payment and slip are needed to secure your son/daughter's place on this trip.

Parent Pay will open on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December at 330pm for Year 9 students only. The trip will then open to all Year 7 and 8 students (should there still be places available) on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December at 330pm.
