Chair's report to committee 2018-2019

So, we have come to an end of our second year of operation of CHSA. While most of the old-timers, myself included, carried on in CHSA for the second year, we were also joined by some new members, both from the parents' community as well as from the school. Their input, help and ideas have been invaluable to the team. Together we have been able to make many events happen and have shared the load of organising.

Last year we were able to meet in the school premises, which was welcomed after a year of trying to shout over the music in Twynersh, or trying to find a private corner in Riverbourne. Being able to have a set location certainly made a difference to our monthly meetings, making them more enjoyable, productive and fun. Also, having a member of the school present made it easier to direct the questions and requests to the right place in a timely manner.

The new school year, a year ago, started with the traditional year 7 welcome disco, which is always well-attended. This year we had no stink bombs, so we can consider it a success. The disco raised £552, plus we also saw some funky moves (mostly on the teachers' part).

Throughout the year we have had many events for kids, adults and the community. To list a few: cake stand at Goose Fair, raising £190; Quiz Night, with Monsieur 'Owell as the quiz master, raising £277; and the annual main event CHS Summer Fair, raising £1,094. Our treasurer, Ian, will update you shortly on exact finances of the year, but I'm glad to be able to report that in total we raised £5,846 last school year.

Some of this money has been spent on essential purchases for CHSA, such as BBQ, folding tables and catering items, but most of the money has been spent on the school, on items such as table tennis tables, basketball hoops, library books, bibles etc...

While I have thoroughly enjoyed my two years as the Chair of CHSA, it is now time to hand in my gavel and open the space for someone new, with less of a Kim Jong-Un leadership style (as I have been referred to in some circles). I will, however, continue to be very much a part of CHSA and help in any way I can.

Now, before I hand over I'd like to thank everyone in the CHSA team for their hard work this year, the school for their support, the whole school community; students, parents and carers for their support, help and participation. We could not have done it without you.
