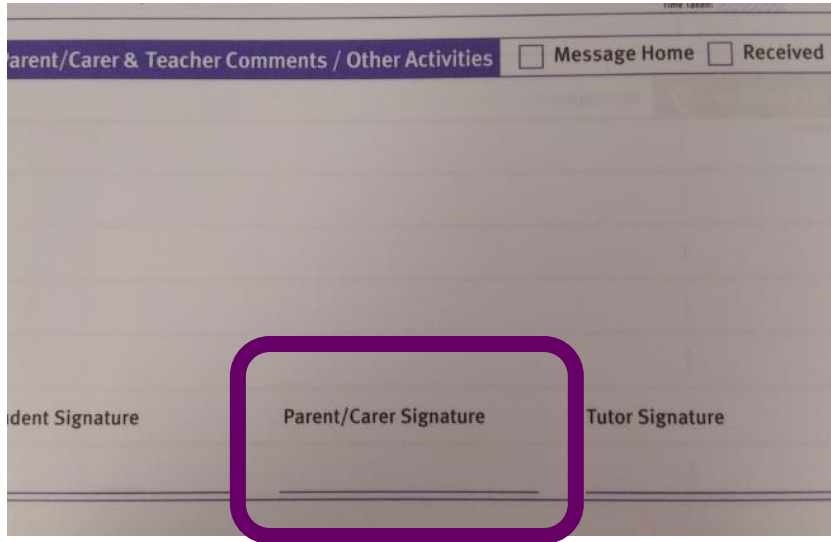

It is your child's responsibility to get it signed. Failure to do so will mean a sanction





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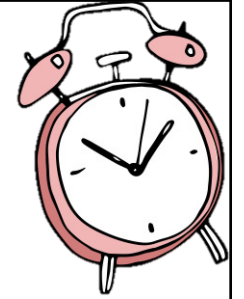
# Attendance

90% Attendance

= ½ **day** off per week

= **4 weeks** off per year

= ½ **a year** missed in 5 years



## WHY ATTENDANCE MATTERS



Being present and on time has a positive impact on learning from K-12

### Stay on Track

It is difficult to "catch up" when time is missed. Starting the day late can impact your child's entire day and effects the whole classroom.

### Reduce Anxiety

Your child will feel connected academically & socially when they have good attendance.

### Build Confidence

Good school attendance helps to build habits that will last a lifetime and transfer to life beyond public school.



# Expectations: Uniform

# Uniform Expectations: Uniform

- ✘ No makeup
- ✘ No extremes of hair style or colour
- ✘ Long hair on girls & boys must be worn up
- ✘ No extreme differentiation in the length of boys' hair
  
- ✓ One watch
- ✓ One pair of plain metal studs for girls
- ✘ No earrings for boys
- ✘ No rings for boys or girls
  
- ✓ Pencil cases must be transparent





# Uniform Expectations: Shoes

**Shoes should be black leather. Vans or trainer/plimsoll style shoes are not permitted**

- **White ankle socks for girls**
- **Grey tights in the winter**
- **Plain black socks for boys**

## Expectations: **Mobile Phones**

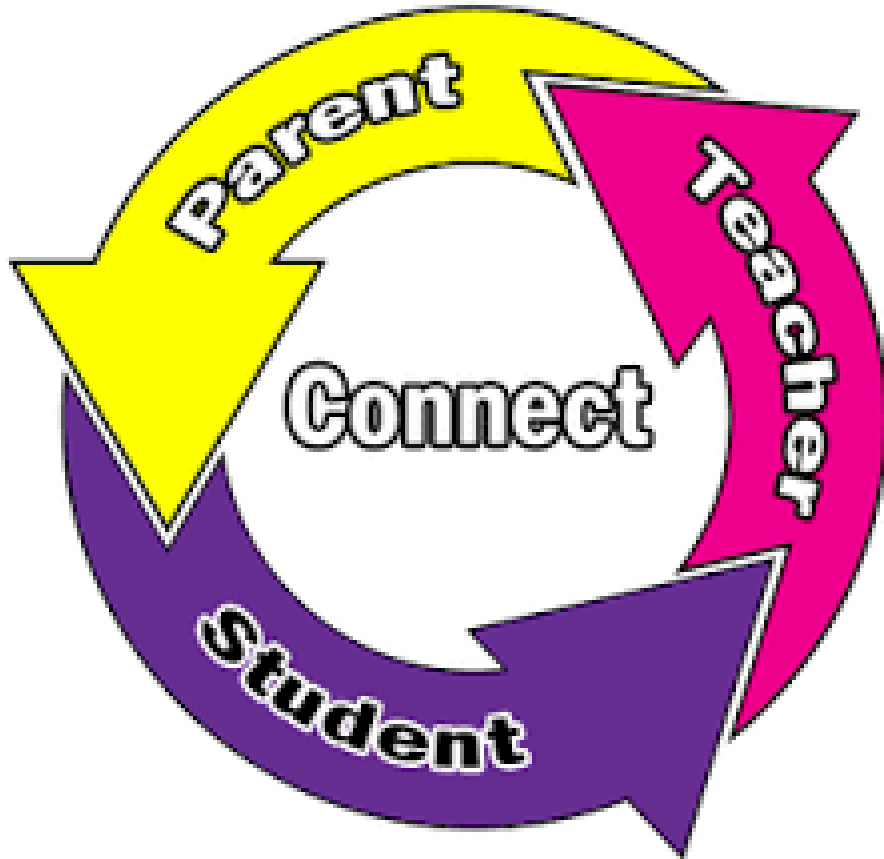
- Must not be seen or used at any time during the school day – this includes detentions

## Confiscated Phones:
